
## FIRST MEETING:

VISIT TO ASHADAN: On 17th December 2019 at 10.00 a.m., the DLLE unit organized a visit to Ashadaan, a home for abandoned, destitute, differently-abled children and HIV-positive people. The visit aimed to sensitize 30 students about social issues. Professor Vaishali Bankar, Convenor of DLLE, and Professor Kirtikumar Pimpliskar, a member of DLLE accompanied the students during the visit. Sister Savita, in charge of Ashadaan, introduced the students to the patients and showed them the purpose, services, and rehabilitation of destitute and abandoned children. The trust staff members treated abandoned female senior citizens with special care and affection. During the visit, the students interacted with senior citizens and special children. They were made aware of the stigma and discrimination that homeless, physically and mentally challenged people face. Snacks and eatables were given to be distributed to Sister Savita. After the visit, students were given refreshments. The visit concluded with a vote of thanks by Prof. Kirtikumar Pimpliskar. The visit was successful in achieving its objectives.
